CONSTITUTION OF THE GEOLOGICAL SOCIETY OF CHINA

Revised and passed by the Eighth Annual

Meeting May 1st, 1981.

- Art. I. This Society shall be known as the Geological Society of China.
- Art. II. The object of this Society shall be the advancement of geology and its allied sciences.
- Art. III The membership of the Society shall consist of members, associates, corresponding members, and honorary members.

The following persons shall be eligible for membership in the Society.

- A. As members, geologists or other scientists interested in geology and its allied sciences.
- B. As honorary members, geologists of exceptional eminence who have conspicuously contributed to the advancement of Chinese geology.
- C. As corresponding members, geologists of note residing abroad who have contributed to geological investigation in China.
- D. As associates, college students of good standing in the studies of geology and its allied sciences.
- Art. IV. Any candidate desiring to be admitted as a member or as an associate must be nominated by two members and elected by the vote of the council. This election may be conducted by correspondance. The corresponding members and the honorary members are to be elected by the general meeting on the recommendation of the council.
- Art. V. Members and associates are entitled to vote, only members are entitled to hold office.
- Art. VI. The Society shall hold one general meeting each year which shall be for the elections of members of the council, the transaction of business, the reading and discussion of scientific papers and geological excursions.

Special meetings may be held for the reading and discussion of scientific papers.

The date and place of the general meeting shall be decided and communicated to the members by the council two months in advance.

- Art. VII. The Council of the Society shall be composed of ex-officio members and six elected members. The retired Presidents of the Society shall be ex-officio members of the Council for a term of three years.
- Art. VIII. Three executive members shall be elected by and from the Council, including one President, one Secretary and one Treasurer.

- Art. IX. The executive members of the council shall be elected for one year and not be eligible for re-election for more than three successive terms. Members of the council shall hold office for three years; one third of the number is to be re-elected each year.
- Art. X. The election for the members of the council can be conducted by correspondance before the annual general meeting, if this is decided by the retiring council.
- Art. XI. Any important business of the Society must receive the approval of the council before it is transacted by the executive members.
 - The quorum of the council meeting shall be half of the total number including ex-officio members.
 - In case it is impossible to have a council meeting, important business may be submitted to the members of the council by correspondence. But any urgent business can be transacted by the president or the secretary subject to the later approval of the council.
 - In case of the resignation of any executive member or his inability of continuating his duty, an acting officer may be appointed by the council to act in his capacity until the new election.
- Art. XII. In any place where there are more than five residing members a local section may be formed and local meetings may be held for the transaction of local business and the reading and discussion of scientific papers.
- Art. XIII. Publication or publications shall be issued by the Society to record (1) the proceedings of all the general and special meetings, (2) news or reports of local sections and (3) scientific papers read in the general and local meetings.
 - A committee of publication shall be formed with members recommended by the editor who is to be elected by the council. This committee has the power of accepting or rejecting any paper submitted for publication.

Art. XIV. Membership dues for members shall be five dollars each year and for associates two dollars.

Membership dues of fifty dollars paid up at one time shall entitle a member to life-membership.

Art. XV. Financial support in addition to membership fees may be obtained from special contributions.

Special permanent funds shall be administered by special committees to be elected by the council and under special regulations approved by the council.

- Art. XVI. The Society may found and award medals or research funds for the encouragement of geological works.
- Art. XVII. There shall be by-laws for matters not included in this constitution.
- Art. XVIII. This constitution may be amended by a two-third vote at the annual meeting after the amendment is submitted by more than five members.

第十二條 在各地方有常駐會員五人以上時得組織分合

第十三條 本會出版刊物雕刊載 (一) 大會 (年會或臨時會) 之紀錄 (二) 各地分會之消息或報告 (三) 大會或分會之論文

出版事務由理事會就會員中推定出版主任一人或二人並由出版主任推定數人組織出版委員會此委員會對於論文之刊 殺有去取之權
